Health camps have been organized in all PACS, blocks and DCCBs</p> <p>Under the International Year of Cooperatives (IYC 2025), health camps were successfully organized at PACS level in all districts and blocks of Bihar. These camps were held at PACS premises, District Central Cooperative Bank premises. The District Cooperative Officer, along with the Managing Director of the District Central Cooperative Bank and the Assistant Registrar, coordinated the event. The District Civil Surgeon supervised the health services provided at the camp. All PACS chairman and managers of cooperative societies were informed and took part in the program. A report of the event has been prepared and shared with the department as per the SOP.</p> <p>2. Swachhata hi Seva Campaign under IYC Campaign</p> <p>Under the International Year of Cooperatives 2025 (IYC 2025) and the Swachhata Hi Seva-2025 (SHS-2025) campaign, Swachhata Utsav was successfully organized across all cooperative department offices and cooperative societies from 19th September to 2nd October 2025. The program included health camps for sanitation workers, awareness sessions on government welfare schemes, rangoli competitions under the Clean Green Utsav, "One Day, One Hour Together" cleaning drives, and art-from-waste contests.</p> <p>3. 5. One-day training cum workshop for Primary Beekeeping and Processing Societies was organized at DNS RICM, Patna

A one-day training and workshop for honey producers was held at DNS RICM, Patna on 20th September 2025 under the International Year of Cooperatives (IYC) campaign. It was organized by the Cooperative Department, Government of Bihar. Members of honey cooperative societies attended the event to learn about beekeeping and honey processing. The training covered topics like caring for bees, collecting honey, and selling it in the market. Senior officials like the Secretary, RCS, and nodal officers were also present. The program helped honey producers improve their skills and earn better income.

Health camps have been organized in all PACS, blocks and DCCBs</p> <p>Health camps were successfully conducted across all Primary Agricultural Credit Societies (PACS), blocks, and District Central Cooperative Banks (DCCBs) in Bihar as part of the International Year of Cooperatives 2025. These camps were held at designated cooperative premises and coordinated by the District Cooperative Officers, Managing Directors of DCCBs, and Assistant Registrars, with medical supervision provided by the District Civil Surgeons. The initiative ensured wide participation from PACS chairman, managers, and cooperative members, demonstrating strong inter-departmental collaboration and community engagement.</p> <p>The health camps provided essential medical services and health awareness to cooperative members, especially in rural areas where access to healthcare is limited. They strengthened the link between cooperative institutions and public health systems, promoting a holistic approach to member welfare. The camps also helped build trust and visibility for cooperative societies within their communities. As per the Standard Operating Procedure (SOP), detailed reports, photographs, and videos were submitted to the department, ensuring transparency and documentation of the initiative's impact.</p> <p>2.Swachhata Hi Seva Campaign (Swachhata Utsav)</p> <p>The Swachhata Hi Seva-2025 campaign, held during the International Year of Cooperatives 2025, brought many positive results. Offices and society premises became cleaner and more hygienic, and people developed a stronger sense of working together for cleanliness. Health camps gave sanitation workers important medical help, while awareness sessions informed them about government welfare schemes. Fun activities like rangoli making and art-from-waste competitions encouraged creativity and care for the environment. The "One Day, One Hour Together" cleaning drives-built teamwork and community spirit. On Gandhi Jayanti, sanitation workers and competition winners were honoured, which helped promote respect, inclusion, and pride in cooperative values. Overall, the campaign created lasting awareness and unity in both offices and communities.</p> <p>3.Celebration of Mukhyamantri Adarsh PACS Protsahan Yojna under IYC Campaign 2025</p> <p>The Mukhyamantri Adarsh PACS Protsahan Yojna 2025 marked a significant milestone in strengthening the cooperative movement in Bihar. Under this flagship initiative, 100 best-performing Primary Agricultural Credit Societies (PACS) across the state were identified and felicitated for their outstanding contributions to cooperative development. The recognition of top-performing PACS at the state level, with awards of ₹15 lakh, ₹10 lakh, and ₹7 lakh for first, second, and third positions respectively, showcased the government's commitment to promoting excellence and transparency in cooperative governance. Additionally, district-level evaluations led to the awarding of</p>

सक्य ब्यूरो, जागरण. पटना : राज्य के 534 प्रखंडों में से 529 में प्राथमिक सब्जी उत्पादक समितियों की स्थापना की जा चुकी है, जिसके माध्यम से 50 हजार से अधिक सब्जी उत्पादक किसान लाभान्वित हो रहे हैं। इन किसानों की सुविधा के लिए संबंधित प्रखंडों में तरकारी आउटलेट जल्द खोले जाएंगे। सोमवार को सहकारिता मंत्री डा. प्रेम कुमार ने उज्ज्वी आडिटीरियम में यह बात कही। इससे पहले उन्होंने प्राथमिक सब्जी उत्पादक समितियों से जुड़े पदाधिकारियों के क्षमतावर्द्धन हेतु प्रशिक्षण व कार्यशाला का उद्घाटन किया। इस मौके पर उन्होंने बेगूसराय जिले के मटिलानी व तेघड़ा, नालंदा के एकनारसराय, समस्तीपुर के ताजपुर में प्याज भंडारण हेतु गोदाम

अध्यक्षों और सहकारिता विभाग के पदाधिकारियों ने भाग लिया कार्यशाला का उद्घाटन सहकारिता मंत्री डा. प्रेम कुमार ने किया। इस अवसर पर उन्होंने कहा कि राज्य सरकार का लक्ष्य सब्जी उत्पादक किसानों को संगठित कर उन्हें उन्नत तकनीक, बीज और बाजार तक सीधी पहुँच उपलब्ध कराना है। उन्होंने बताया कि PVCS मॉडल के जरिए किसान के विभिन्न जिलों से आए PVCS

संकेतों और विचारों पर निर्भरता घटेगी। मंत्री ने अर्नलहन माध्यम से मटिलानी, तेघड़ा, एकनारसराय और ताजपुर में प्याज भंडारण हेतु गोदाम निर्माण तथा वाट, ताजपुर, हिलसा, विद्यापति और चिहियाँ में PVCS के आधारभूत संरचना निर्माण का शिलान्यास भी किया। यह पहल किसानों को भंडारण और विपणन की बेहतर सुविधा देने में मील का पत्थर साबित होगी।
