The Bulk Milk Cooler will reduce the wastage of milk, especially in summer seasons, thereby, increasing the income of the dairy farmers. The Deputy Registrar highlighted the functioning of the Cooperative Department especially after the formation of the Union Ministry of Cooperation which provided impetus to the revival of the Cooperative movement in the J&K. The Deputy Registrar explained in detail regarding Computerisation of PACS, Food Processing UHI, Jan Aushadi Kendra and bank reconversion among other things. 		PACS	At JHC PALLANWALA MPCS JHC, KHOUR, Block Khour	Inauguration of Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Aushadi Kendra	As part of the Government of India's flagship initiative under the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Aushadi Pariyojana (PMBJP), a Jan Aushadi Kendra (JAK) was established at Community Health Centre (CHC) Khour, managed by Pallanwala Multi-Purpose Cooperative Society Ltd. The Kendra became operational on 07th June, 2024, and is functioning under License No. RL/F20JK2024G09717. Since its opening, the Kendra has made remarkable progress in fulfilling its core objective — ensuring the availability of quality generic medicines at affordable prices to the common public. These medicines are offered at prices that are approximately 50% to 80% lower than their branched counterparts, thereby significantly reducing the out-of-pocket healthcare expenditure for patients especially those from rural and economically weaker sections. From 07th February, 2024 to 31st March, 2025, the Jan Aushadi Kendra has recorded a total sale of ₹7,32,000, reflecting strong community engagement and a rising preference for cost-effective healthcare solutions. Beyond healthcare delivery, this Jan Aushadi Kendra has also contributed positively towards local economic empowerment. It has provided a sustainable livelihood to Mr. Ronit Sharma, son of Sudash Chander, who is a member of the Pallanwala MPCS. His active involvement in the daily operations of the Kendra demonstrates how this initiative is not only improving health outcomes but also creating meaningful employment opportunities at the grassroots levels. The continued success of the Jan Aushadi Kendra at CHC Khour is a testament to the impactful implementation of PMBJP — bringing affordable healthcare within reach while simultaneously strengthening rural entrepreneurship and cooperative societies.
