

Training cum sensitization program (in 02 batches) for ARs/DRs/JRs, Cooperative Department, GoUP under PACS Computerization Project at BIRD, Lucknow

Cooperative Department, Government of Uttar Pradesh, in collaboration with Uttar Pradesh State Cooperative Bank (UPCB) conducted a two-day residential training program in two batches for Joint/Deputy/Assistant Commissioners and Joint/Deputy/Assistant Registrars from all 75 districts of the State. The first programme, held on 9–10 June 2025, included officials from 45 districts, while the second programme on 11–12 June 2025 covered the remaining 30 districts.

The programme was coordinated by officials from the State Project Management Unit (SPMU), NABARD Regional Office and the UPCB. A pre-training assessment was conducted via Google Forms to gauge participants' awareness of project activities and terminologies.

The programme was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Minister of Cooperation, GoUP, Shri Jayendra Pratap Singh Rathore. Distinguished dignitaries including Shri Nirupam Mehrotra (Director, BIRD), Shri Pankaj Kumar (CGM, NABARD-RO), Shri Anil Kumar Singh (Additional Commissioner and Registrar, Dept. of Cooperative), Shri R.K. Kulshertha (MD, UPCB), and Shri S.C. Mishra (Additional MD, UPCB) graced the inaugural event.

The Hon'ble Minister emphasized the importance of regular review meetings by District Registrars with ARs, ADCOs, and ADOs, ensuring farmers' benefits from Central and State Government schemes, timely achievement of M-PACS and E-PACS targets and encouraged active participation and learning during the training. He also emphasised on the need of Data entry operators, Day End activity, reducing the Parking Account amount and formation of 1730 new mPACS as per the target given by the RCS office.

Key technical sessions included *Common Accounting System & NPA in B-PACS, Overview of PACS Computerisation Scheme, Optimal number of PACS in UP, Revision & Monitoring Mechanism, Standard Operating Procedures & ERP Software Introduction.*

During the programme a report made by the UP RO on Availability of PACS in UP based on comparative study of 13 States was also presented. Hands-on training on ERP software was also conducted in the computer lab. A post-training assessment and physical feedback collection were also done to evaluate the effectiveness of the sessions.
