In February 2025, several Financial Literacy Camps (FLCs) were conducted across various states in India. These camps aimed to enhance financial awareness and literacy among the cooperative members and the general public.

In Jammu & Kashmir, FLCs were organized to educate the community about financial management and cooperative schemes. Bihar also hosted FLCs to spread awareness about financial literacy and the benefits of cooperative initiatives. Chhattisgarh

conducted similar camps focusing on the importance of cyber security and financial management for cooperative banks.

Himachal Pradesh held FLCs to discuss the role of cooperatives in credit flow to small & marginal farmers and household financial planning. In Madhya Pradesh, the camps emphasized the special theme of cooperatives for the year 2025-26. Punjab organized FLCs under the International Year of Cooperative; the meeting was chaired by the Chief Secretary.

Rajasthan celebrated the International Year of Cooperatives by conducting FLCs to promote financial literacy. West Bengal also hosted FLCs as part of their state credit seminar. Sikkim's FLCs aimed to monitor the health of cooperative credit institutions and improve financial literacy.

Tamil Nadu highlighted the projections of credit by cooperative banks during their FLCs. Tripura's camps focused on cooperative themes and financial awareness. Maharashtra discussed the International Year of Cooperatives and conducted FLCs to enhance financial literacy.

Nagaland organized FLCs as part of their campaign on cooperation among cooperatives. Telangana held workshops and FLCs to reduce imbalances at the PACS level. Gujarat's FLCs were part of their state credit seminar, discussing the potential for credit flow by cooperative banks in 2025-26.
