Important issues discussed	<p>On 5th June 2025 as per the monthly plan of activities at District level under IYC a program on promotion of Natural and Organic Farming was organized at Taloor PACS Narot Jaimal Singh on the occasion of World Environment Day 2025. Discussions were held with the participants regarding significance and role of cooperatives in financial inclusion and equitable growth. PACS role in rural economy was duly highlighted and need for strengthening such grassroot level organizations was emphasized. PACS secretaries of Taloor and Sunderchak were motivated regarding taking up keen interest in ongoing programs being implemented by MoC & NABARD such as PACS computerization and its importance for the cooperative ecosystem. They were also prompted to take up diversified business activities to enhance the viability of PACS.</p> <p>Scientists from KVK shared their advise regarding optimum use of inputs such as insecticides, pesticides and fertilizers to increase their returns. They emphasized on the concept of Maximum Residue Level in agriculture produce and its adverse impact on human health. Concept of Natural and Organic farming were explained to the farmers and they were urged to make transition towards the same for sustainable agriculture.</p> <p>A plantation drive was also organised at Taloor village and nearly 100 plants of litchi, mango, lemon and agroforestry were distributed among the participants.</p>
