### C. Purpose of Visit/ Meeting:

Training Programme on Natural Farming as a part of ICY 2025 at Krishak Bandhu Kendra, Dasda, North Tripura.

### D. Gist of Visit/ Meeting:

Organised Training Programme on Natural Farming as a part of ICY 2025 at Krishak Bandhu Kendra, Dasda, North Tripura. The objective of the programme is to generate awareness and impart foundational knowledge on natural farming techniques among farmers of the locality, enabling them to gradually transition to more sustainable and cost-effective agricultural practices. The programme was attended by the Vice Chairman, BAC, North Tripura, Secretary, Growing Seed, SMS, KVK, North Tripura and as many as 25-30 Farmers form various location of Dasda Block, North Tripura.

At the outset, the DDM, NABARD welcomed all the participants and briefed on the aim and objective of the training programme, viz., "Natural Farming & Climate Smart Agriculture" and highlighted various initiatives & support extended by NABARD in the State/district.

The sessions on Natural Farming and Climate Smart Agriculture was taken by Subject Matter Specialist (SMS) as a resource person from KVK, Panisagar respectively. They explain on the core principles of natural farming, which emphasizes working with natural ecosystems, minimizing external inputs (like synthetic fertilizers and pesticides), and promoting soil health, biodiversity, and resilience. The farmers were also sensitized on how natural farming aligns with climate-smart agriculture, which aims to sustainably increase agricultural productivity, adapt to climate change, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. The live demonstration on preparation of Jeevamrutha was made.

The Vice-Chairman, BAC, Dasda block thanks & appreciated NABARD and expressed gratitude for organizing the training programme which will improve soil health, reduced input costs, enhanced environmental sustainability, and the potential for increased farmer's income.
