Brief Information on the Activity	<p>The Tamil Nadu Cooperative Union, Chennai, and the Cooperative Development Board of the Institute of Cost Accountants of India jointly celebrated the International Year of Cooperatives at Pillar Hall, Madurai, from 25th June to 1st July 2025. As part of the celebration, a two-day in-campus training programme was conducted in three batches on the theme “<b>Financial Governance and Accountability in Cooperatives</b>” for financial professionals of cooperative institutions in TamilNadu.</p> <p>The Institute of Cost Accountants acted as the knowledge partner by designing content and engaging eminent resource persons for the sessions.
