Shri Khetivadi Upastha Bazar Samiti-Talaja has provided insurance coverage to approximately one lakh forty six thousand farmer account holders of Talaja taluka. Under the insurance scheme, cheques were presented to the heirs of 11 farmer account holders.

ખેત જણસની સતત આવક, સારા ઉત્પાદનના કારણે તળાજા માર્કેટિંગ યાર્ડએ આ વખતે નોંધપાત્ર નહીં કર્યો તો તેમની સાથે અકસ્માતે મૃત્યુ પામનાર ખેડૂતના પરિવારજનોને આર્થિક રૂપે મદદ કરવા માટે વીમા કવરેજ સુરક્ષિત કરાયા હોવાથી ૧૧ ખેડૂત પરિવારને ૧-૧ લાખની રકમ ચૂકવવામાં આવી હતી.

યાર્ડ સેક્રેટરી અજિતભાઈ પરમાર એ જણાવ્યું હતું કે, તળાજા તાલુકાના અંદાજિત એકલાખ છેતાલીસ હજાર જેટલા ખેડૂત ખાતેદાર છે. એક વ્યક્તિ દીઠ યાર્ડ દ્વારા રૂ.૧૪ લાખની રકમ ભરવામાં આવે છે. જે કુલ રૂ.૨૦ લાખ થી વધુ ની રકમ ખેડૂતનું અકસ્માતએ મૃત્યુ થાય તો રૂ.૧ લાખની રકમ મળવા પાત્ર બને છે.
