

Celebration of International Year of Cooperative 2025 by DDM Gomati & South Tripura:

Brief Report on One Day Training on Organic Farming at KVK-South Tripura

As part of the International Year of Cooperatives (IYC) 2025 celebrations, a one-day training program on Organic Farming was organized by DDM Gomati & South Tripura at ICAR-KVK, South Tripura. The event was attended by 30 farmer members from various Primary Agricultural Credit Societies (PACS).

In his inaugural address, the DDM highlighted the objectives of IYC 2025 and emphasized the Government of India and NABARD's initiatives aimed at strengthening cooperative societies, particularly PACS.

The DDM informed participants about key policy measures supporting organic agriculture and urged farmers to take advantage of these schemes for promoting sustainable farming practices. The training included technical sessions conducted by Subject Matter Specialists (SMSs) in Agronomy, Vegetable Science, Plant Pathology, and Animal Science. Field visit to vermicomposting pit was also arranged for live demonstration of composting techniques.

The programme successfully enhanced the knowledge and awareness of participants on organic farming, fostering a positive step towards eco-friendly and sustainable agriculture ensuring better returns for the cultivators.
