8	Important issues discussed -	<p>As a part of NB 44th Foundation day celebration and IYC 2025 a promotional event through Co-operatives - Bio-village/Organic farming/ natural farming/ Climate Smart Agriculture/ Solar village etc. was organised through a camp with the farmers practicing organic farming at Kuda Gram Panchayat in Murhu block</p> <p>The event was attended by ATMA Program Director, Khunti Shri Anuranjan Kumar, Horticulture officer Shri A K Singh and BCO from ARCS office Smt. Anju Topno, NBJK (NGO) representatives, farmers and LAMPS officials.</p> <p>Speaking on the event District Development Manager, NABARD highlighted the projects like FPO, Wadi, Watershed etc. being implemented by NABARD in the district for the benefit of the farmers and the tribal community. She also spoke on the efforts being made by NABARD in collaboration with the Registrar of Co-operative Society for PACS Computerisation. She emphasised on the importance of traditional, natural and organic farming. DDM also spoke on the role of Co-operatives for benefit of farmers and highlighted the work being done by NB for promotion of Co-operatives and promotion of NTFP through Van Dhan Vikas Kendra in Murhu.</p> <p>Project Director ATMA, spoke on the schemes being promoted by government for agriculture like KCC, Kisaan Samman Yojana, PMFBY, PM Kusum. He highlighted the importance of traditional farming and the need for conservation of traditional seeds through promotion of seed banks. The Horticulture officer highlighted the support being extended by the department for bee keeping, mushroom cultivation, distribution of seeds and seedlings of plants like mango, litchi, dragon fruit, strawberry, pineapple, banana, Chiku, fig etc., processing units, cold storage, ripening chamber. He also stated that efforts are on to promote cultivation of Kiwi, Avocado and Apple in the district. The officers stated that the schemes of the Government are aimed at increasing the income levels of farmers. The BCO spoke on the schemes of the Co-operative Dept. and urged the farmers to form Co-operatives for their benefit. She also quoted the example of Kewra LAMPS in Murhu who are undertaking sale of lac through Co-operative.</p> <p>The farmers showed interest in availing benefits of the schemes extended by the Government to raise their income and standard of living.</p>
